Community Profile

A very small rural, riverside parish. 2011 Census, population 230. One village and a small number of outlying homes and farms.
Approximately 150 Households in 2016, of which approximately 50 are second homes. The majority of the population are retired from full time employment and there is very limited local employment. Very small scale local businesses related to holiday lets, river based activity, arts and crafts and several farms.

All of the Parish is within an AONB and also includes part of a Marine Conservation Area on the Fowey River. One minor road with passing places gives access to most of the Parish from the B3269. Very minor road and footpath access to other parts of the Parish. Access to Golant village by small craft dependent on tide height. Saints Way Footpath. Narrow steep winding "Cornish Lane" leads down to the only village in the Parish at Golant.
